

VERDE CANYON RAILROAD "SPECIAL EVENT"

Well, the Club Member votes have been cast and the results were unanimous in favor of the Verde Canyon Railroad trip. In second place was Sedona and in third place was the Pima Museum trip. Therefore, the Sedona trip will be scheduled for April 2017.



A Governor's Choice as one of "America's Treasures," the Verde Canyon Railroad Wilderness Route has also been referred to as Arizona's other grand canyon. The trip is Arizona's longest running nature show where endangered and endearing wa-

terfowl and wildlife play and prey in this serene habitat. Enjoy the wilderness of the Verde Canyon from open-air viewing cars of the comfort of first class or deluxe coaches through visual artistry that makes you feel you're experiencing the canyon firsthand.

The journey features towering red rock pinnacles; the babbling, clear waters of the Verde River and an abundance of native flora and fauna. See history and geology unfold around every bend including Sinagua Indian ruins dating back to 600 B.C. Feel and hear the train as it glides through a 680-foot manmade tunnel and crosses a number of remarkable bridges and trestles.

Now, for our Electromotive Members and vintage train enthusiasts, the train is powered by two FP7 locomotives - 2 of only 12 remaining in North America. They are vintage 1953 locomotives built for the Alaskan Railroad. They have been completely restored and began operating at the Verde Canyon Railroad in 1997.

Our April 6, 2016 tour is planned during peak season and the Railroad requests that half of our total cost be paid in advance. First payment due January 15, 2016. Our final payment is due March 15, 2016, so the attached Acknowledgement Form reflects these payment due dates. Please sign up early using the enclosed form.

AWIM EVENT ANNOUNCEMENT



As you know, the GM Retirees Club of Arizona sponsored "A World In Motion" (AWIM) programs in 12 Phoenix area schools and impacted 1,857 students during the 2014/2015 school year, thanks to the support from our GM Retiree Club. Retired GM Engineers were key Site Coordinators and Volunteers in most of the schools. In addition, we are off to a good start for the

2015/2016 school year, but could use a few more volunteers in Tolleson and Surprise. Contact Hal Hubbard (Tolleson) or Tom Terry (Surprise) for more information.

SAE (Society of Automotive Engineers) now has a program like AWIM, for high school students. It's called F1 in Schools. 7 million students from 29 countries have participated in F1 in Schools programs. SAE introduced the program to schools in the US and Canada 3 years ago. It can be a life-changing experience for the students. They design a model F1 race car of the future using 3D CAD software, and race against millions of students world-wide. This school year we will have 11 F1 teams from 4 high schools from the Phoenix Area compete in the SAE sponsored AZ Regional competition which will be held at Perry High School in Gilbert. The event will take place on December 10th and 11th. The teams will be competing for the opportunity to go to Michigan next May to compete in the US/Canada Competition.
